


Important

Assembly Tip

Before you begin, it's best to identify all of the parts and fittings to build your ottoman bed frame. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and to familiarise yourself with all of the parts and fittings before building.

Top Tip

We recommend that you build your new ottoman bed frame in the room you'd like it to be located. This will help prevent any risk of damage to the frame whilst moving it.

Safety and Care

It's important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed frame which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation.



Please ensure that packaging is disposed of in a safe and environmentally friendly way, and recycle where possible. Please keep your assembly instructions safe to refer back to in the future.


Operating Your Ottoman Bed Frame Safely

- Caution, this ottoman bed frame uses a pressurised mechanism.
- Please ensure children and animals are kept away from the ottoman bed frame when operating the mechanism.
- Use caution when operating and always use two hands at arm's length.
- You must always ensure the mattress is on the ottoman bed frame before lifting the mechanism. Failure to do so may result in injury or damage to the mechanism.
- If removing the mattress, make sure the ottoman bed frame is secured as it could flip open.
- Only use the storage compartment when the ottoman bed frame is fully in the upright position.
- Do not sit or lie on the ottoman bed frame whilst the lifting mechanism is in use.
- Beware of entrapment. Keep both hands clear of the mechanism when operating.
- When lifting the ottoman bed frame, remove all bedding except the fitted sheet.
- Always use the strap to lift or lower the ottoman metal frame. Close the ottoman metal frame by pushing down firmly with both hands towards the centre of the bed frame with pressure.
- No children or animals should be left unattended when the ottoman bed frame is in the upright position.
- When fully assembled, raise and lower the ottoman metal frame 4/5 times to ensure the gas pistons are fully lubricated.
- Ensure to re-tighten all nuts and bolts within the ottoman bed frame after the first two weeks of use.







Step 1: Open the zipper behind the headboard and take out the slat (11) & hardware accessories.




Step 2: Attaching the Angle Irons to the Headboard & Footboard.


NB: Before tightening the bolts, please ensure the bed frame is square



Step 5: Fabric Base Attachment.

With an assistant, carefully lift both the Headboard & Footboard at the same time, do not let the bed frame twist. Lift and turn the bed frame on its side holding the bed upright for safety. Attach the Fabric Base (16) to bottom of the Side Rails, Headboard & Footboard with the velcro tape. Ensure the fabric is fixed evenly all round.





Step 7: Attaching the Gas Struts to the Lifting Mechanism.






Note: Please twist the tip of piston to a correct position if unable to connect to the bolt.

Step 8: Screw the Ottoman Metal Frame to each Lift Mechanism.





Step 9: Attaching the Slat Caps to the Ottoman Bed Frame.
