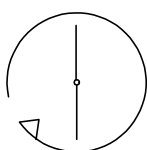
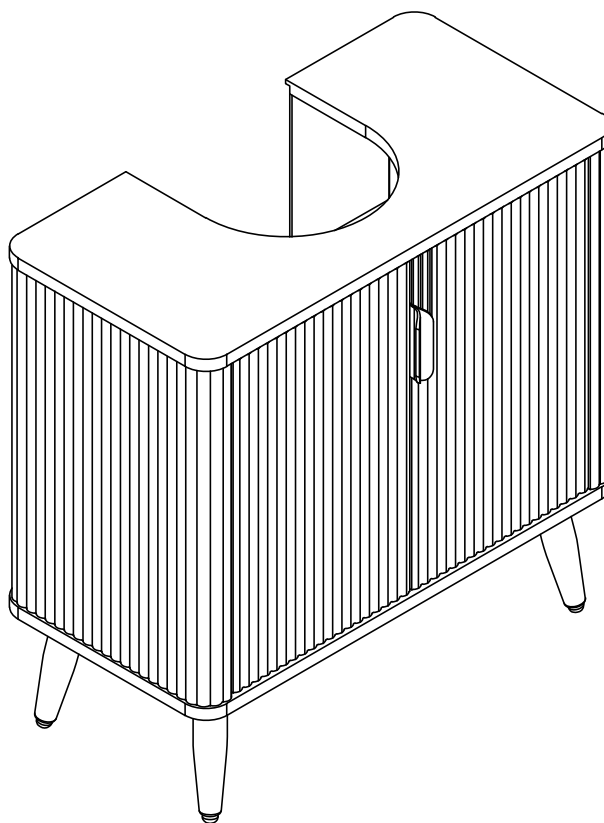
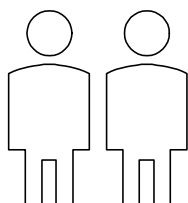


Hattie Under The Sink Cabinet

IMPORTANT

ASSEMBLY TIP

Before you begin, it's best to identify all of the parts and fittings to build your Hattie Under The Sink Cabinet frame. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and to familiarise yourself with all of the parts and fittings before building.

TOP TIP

We recommend that you assemble Hattie Under The Sink Cabinet in the room you'd like it to be located.

This will help prevent any risk of damage to the frame whilst moving it.

SAFETY AND CARE

It's important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this product which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation.

RECYCLING

Please ensure that packaging is disposed of in a safe and environmentally friendly way, and recycle where possible. Please keep your assembly instructions safe to refer back to in the future.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE:

1. Do not drag Hattie Under The Sink Cabinet when moving, lift it off the floor instead.
 2. It is not recommended to place the item next to sources of heat such as radiators, fires or directly exposed to sunlight. This may cause the wood to crack, split or fade due to the heat and humidity.
 3. Wood will mellow and change colour over time, we recommend that ornaments and items placed on the surface to be moved regularly to prevent uneven mellowing.
 4. Regularly check all fixings to ensure none have come loose. Re-tighten if necessary.
 5. Avoid sharp items such as a screwdriver or any pointy tools.
 6. Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly - recycle where possible.
- ▲ To keep your bathroom furniture looking its best, please follow the guidance below.

Cleaning

1. Clean with a soft damp cloth and mild soap solution only.
2. Dry surfaces thoroughly after cleaning.
3. Do not use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads or bleach as these may damage the finish.

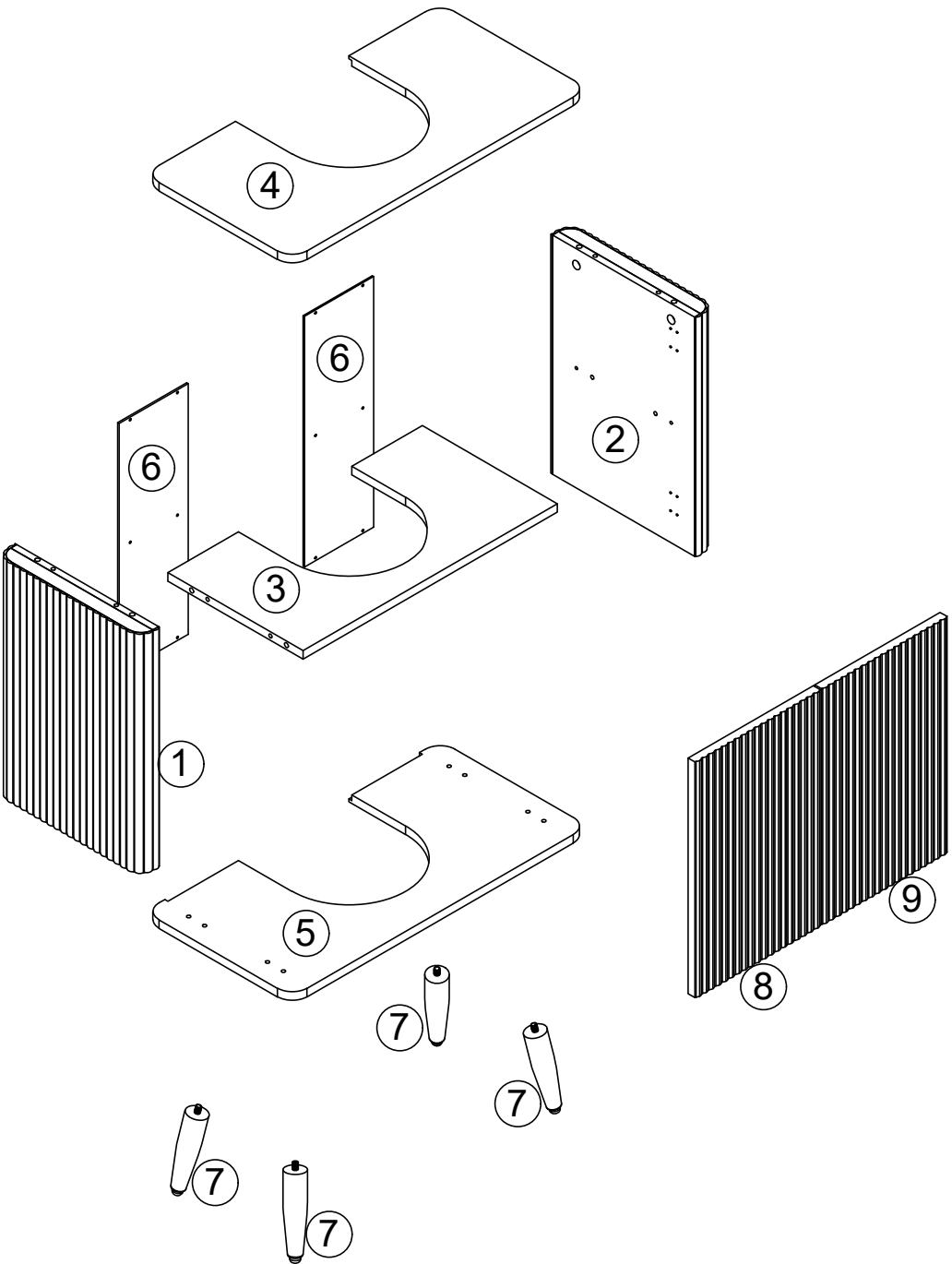
Moisture & Ventilation

1. Always wipe away standing water immediately, particularly around joints, edges, basins, and handles.
2. Ensure the room is well ventilated during and after bathing or showering to reduce humidity build-up.
3. Prolonged exposure to moisture or poor ventilation may cause swelling, edge lifting, or deterioration of the finish over time.

Heat & Steam

1. Avoid direct contact with excessive heat or steam.
2. Avoid scratches, and sharp objects which may damage the painted surface.
3. Slight colour variation or fading over time may occur due to natural exposure to light.
