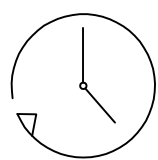
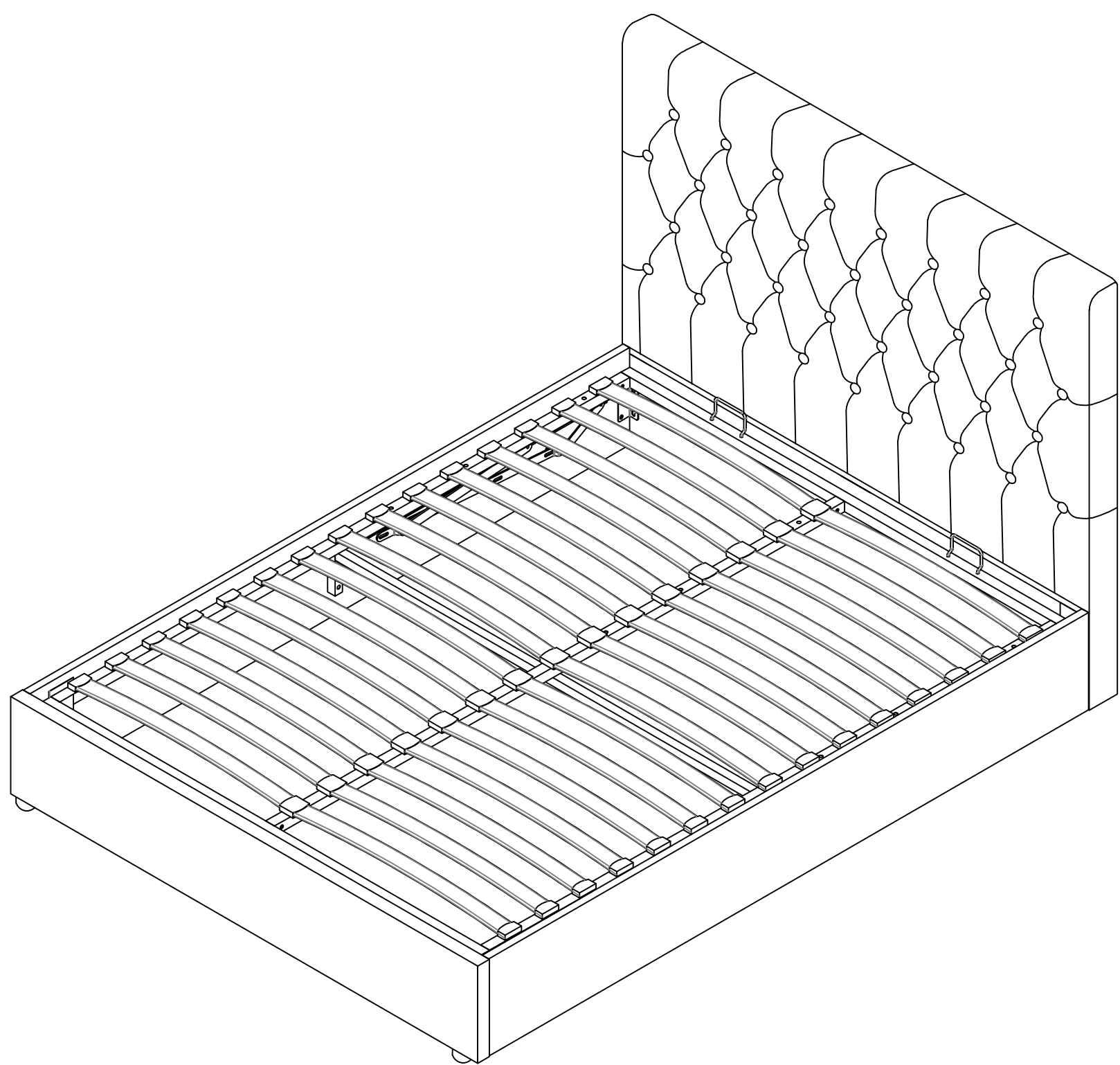


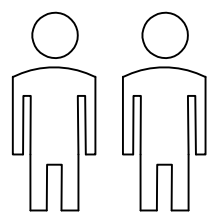

Important

Assembly Tip

Before you begin, it's best to identify all of the parts and fittings to build your ottoman bed frame. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and to familiarise yourself with all of the parts and fittings before building.

Top Tip

We recommend that you build your new ottoman bed frame in the room you'd like it to be located. This will help prevent any risk of damage to the frame whilst moving it.

Safety and Care

It's important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this bed frame which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation.

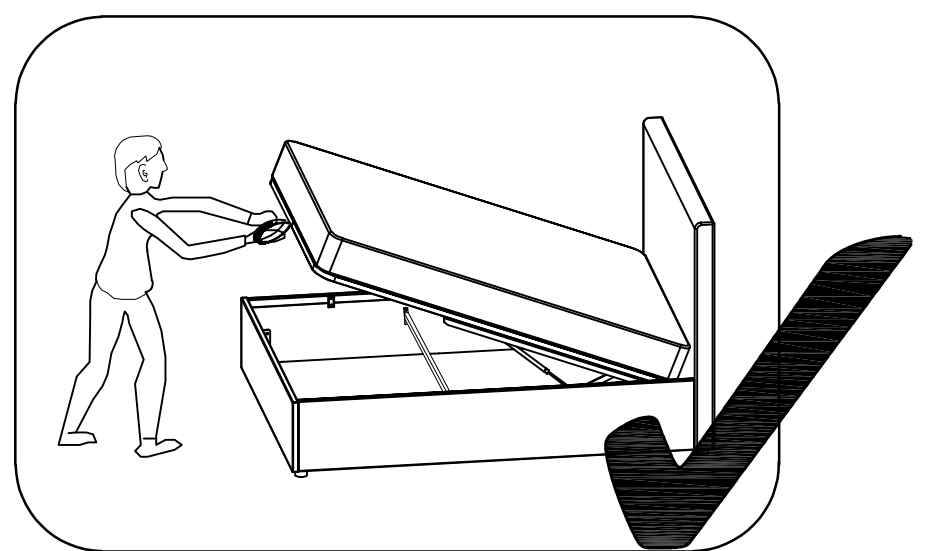
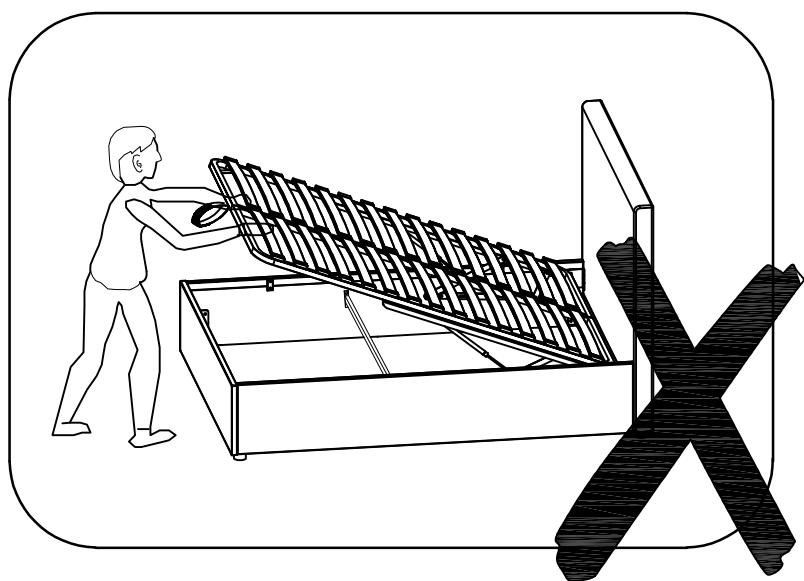
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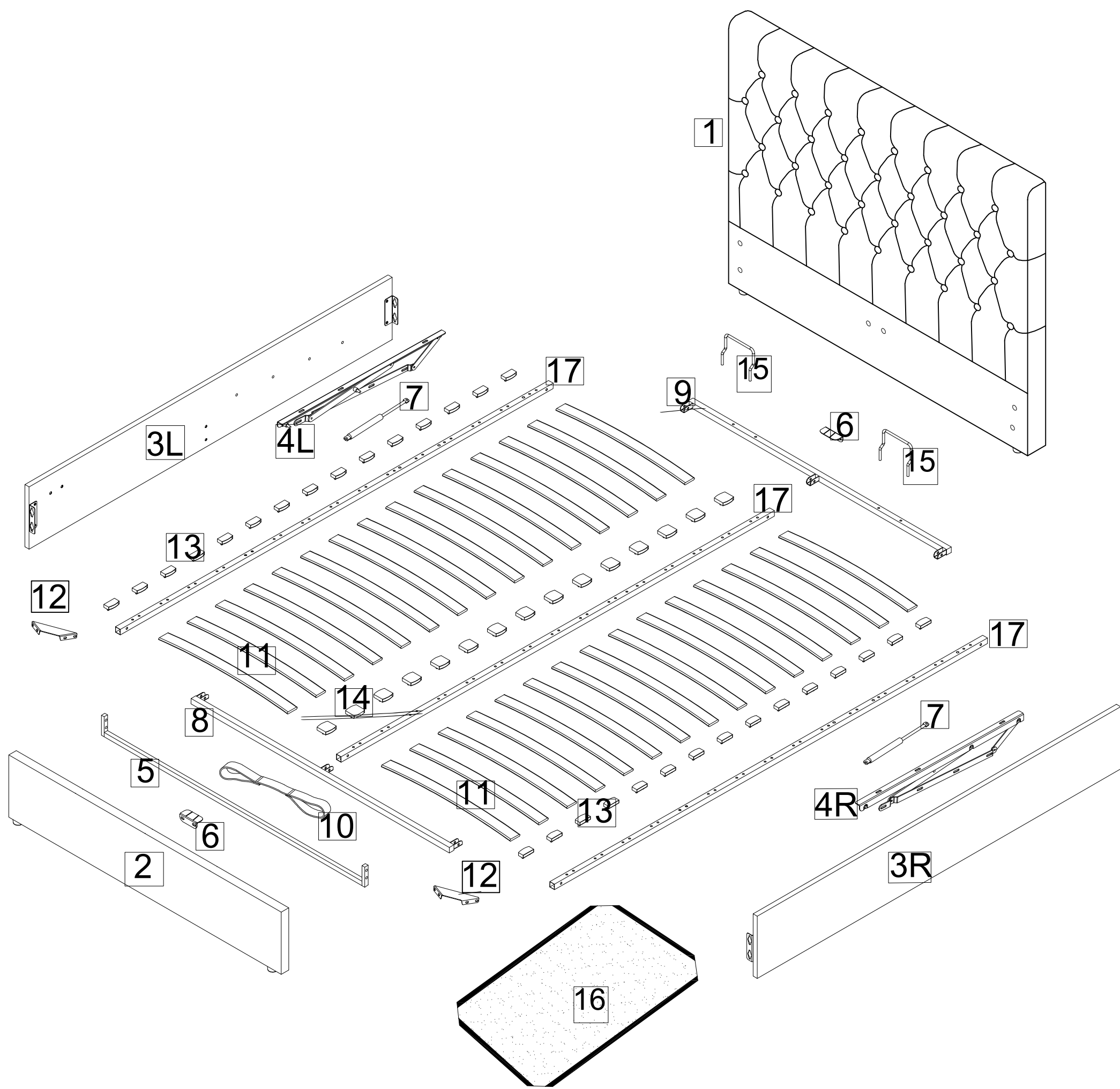
Operating Your Ottoman Bed Frame Safely

- Caution, this ottoman bed frame uses a pressurised mechanism.
- Please ensure children and animals are kept away from the ottoman bed frame when operating the mechanism.
- Use caution when operating, and always use two hands at arm's length.
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- If removing the mattress, make sure the ottoman bed frame is secured as it could flip open.
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- Do not remain on the ottoman bed frame whilst the lifting mechanism is in use.
- Beware of entrapment. Keep both hands clear of the mechanism when operating.
- When lifting the ottoman bed frame, remove all bedding except the fitted sheet.
- Always use the strap to lift or lower the ottoman metal frame. Close the ottoman metal frame by pushing down firmly with both hands towards the centre of the bed frame with equal pressure.
- No children or animals should be left unattended when the ottoman bed frame is in the upright position.
- When fully assembled, raise and lower the ottoman metal frame 4/5 times to ensure the gas pistons are fully lubricated.
- Ensure to re-tighten all nuts and bolts within the ottoman bed frame after the first two weeks of use.

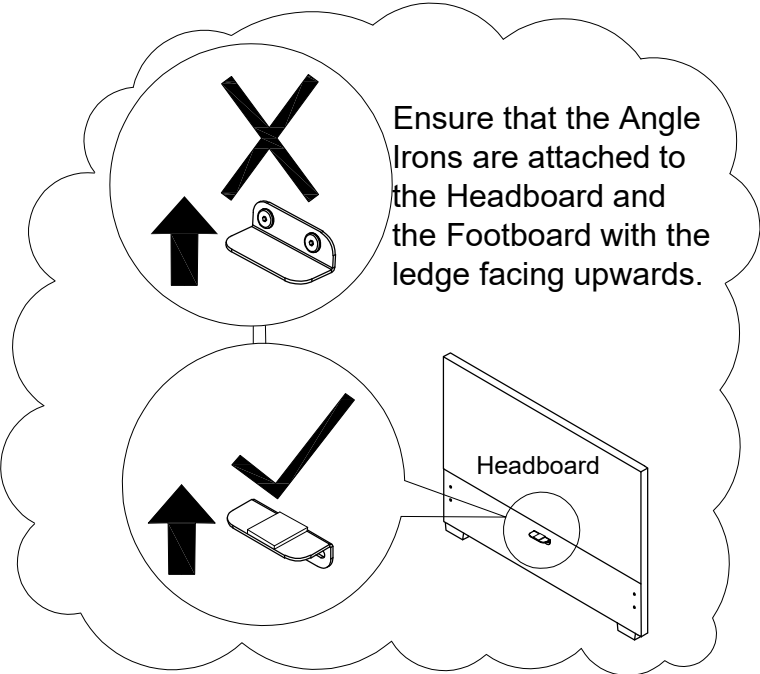
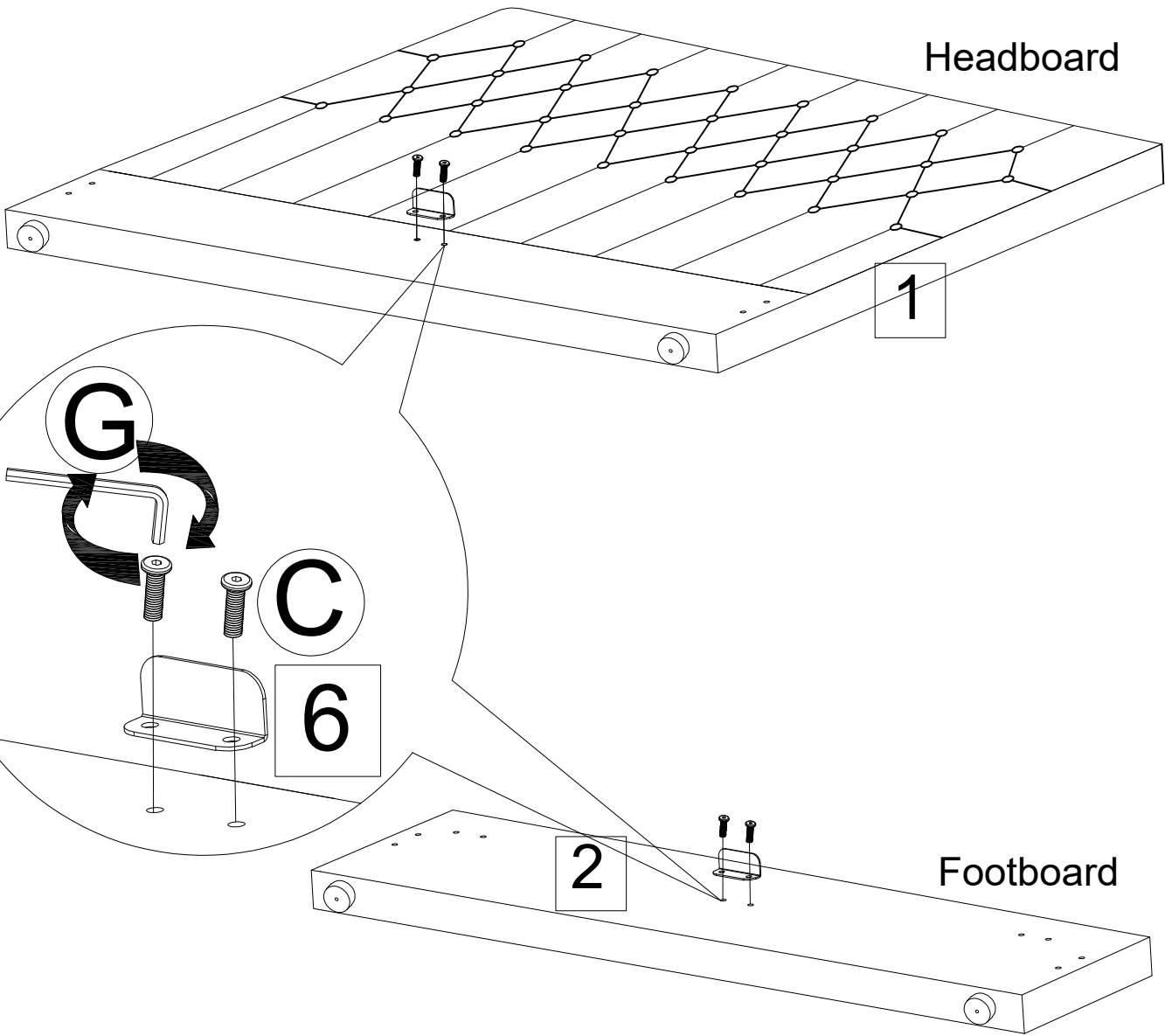
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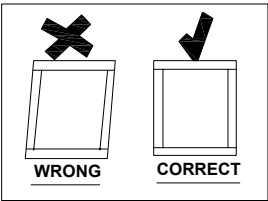
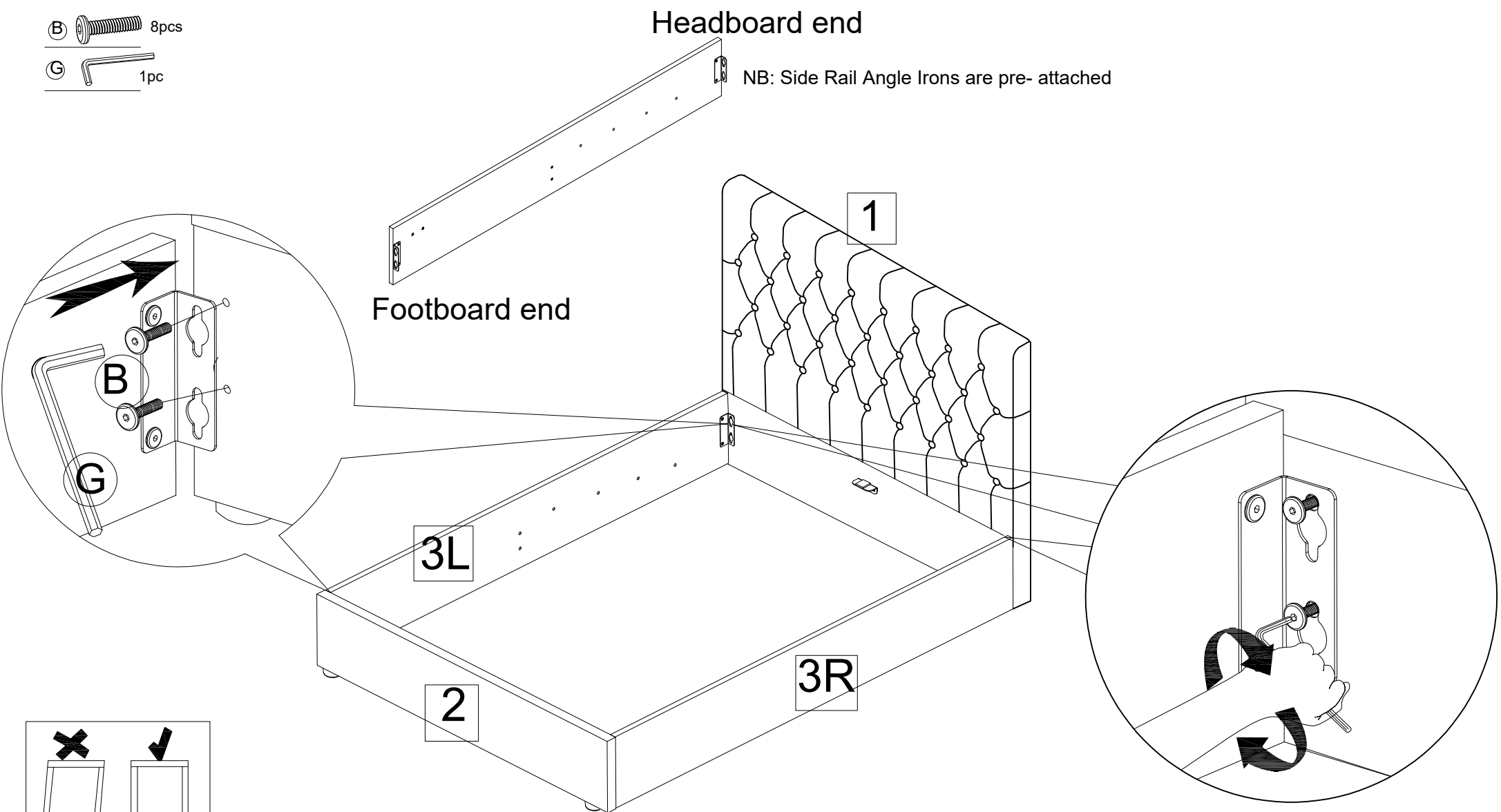
Step 1: Attaching the Angle Irons to the Headboard & Footboard

Step 2: Attaching the Headboard & Footboard to the Side Rails

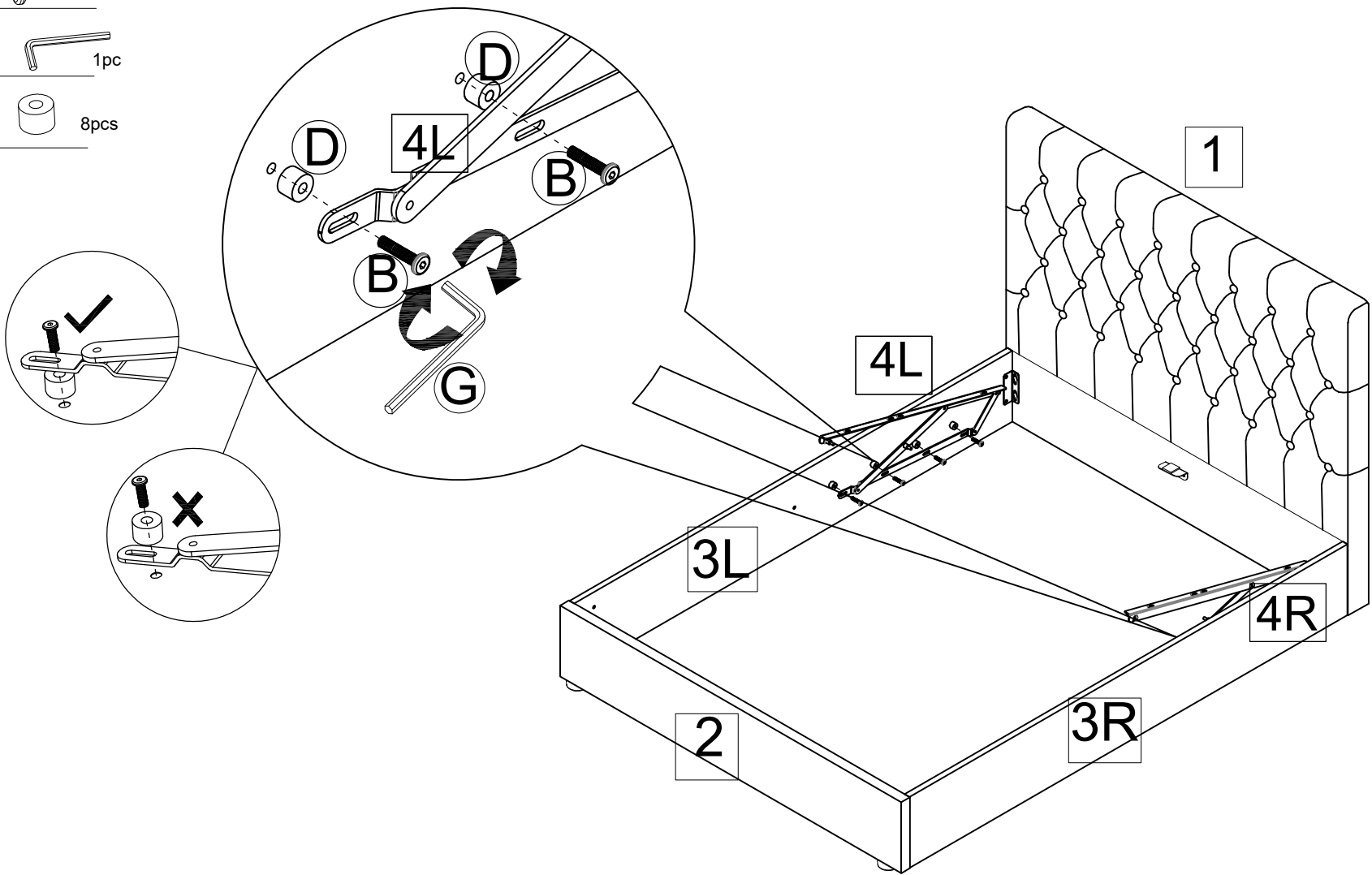

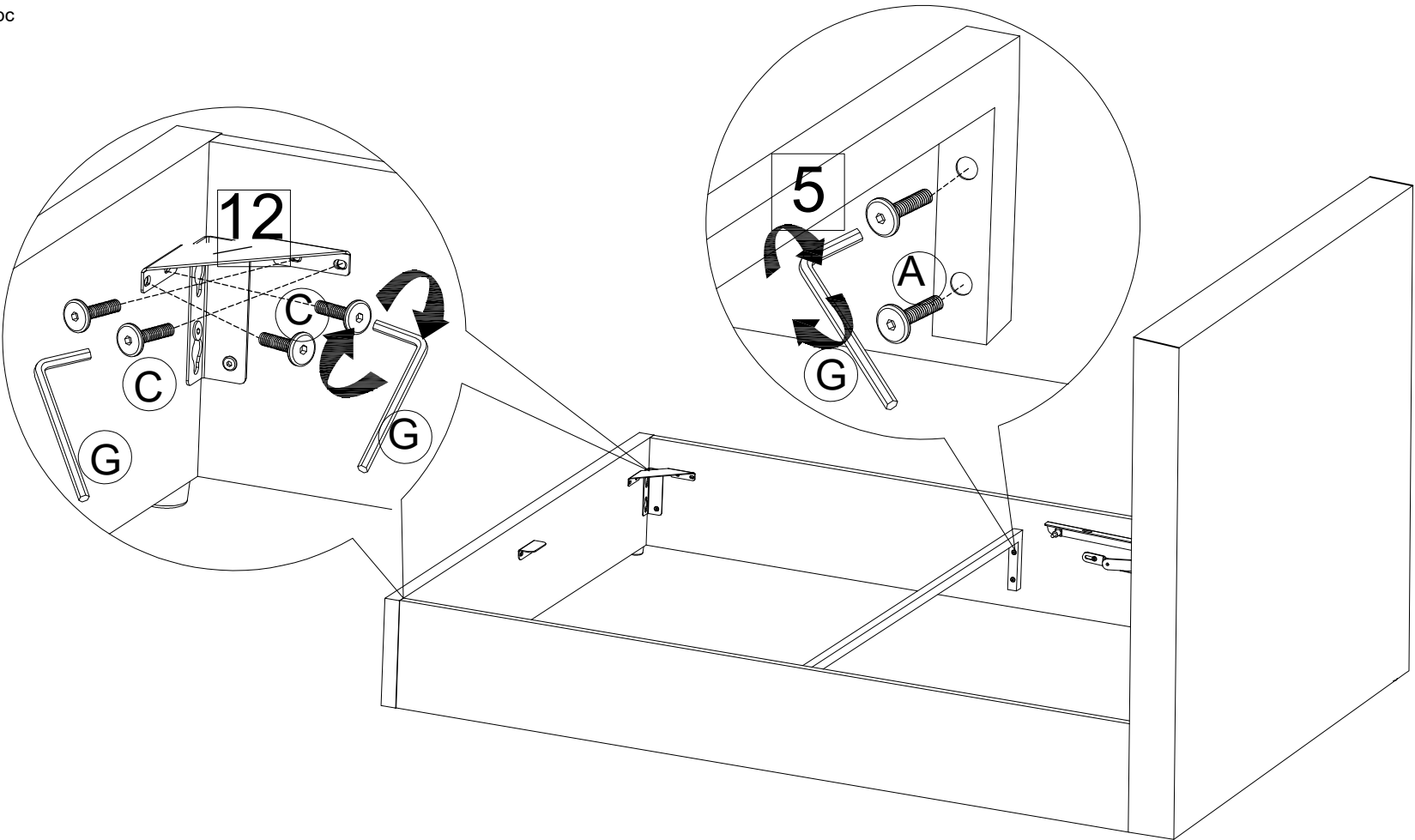
Step 3: Attaching the Side Rails & Lift Mechanisms

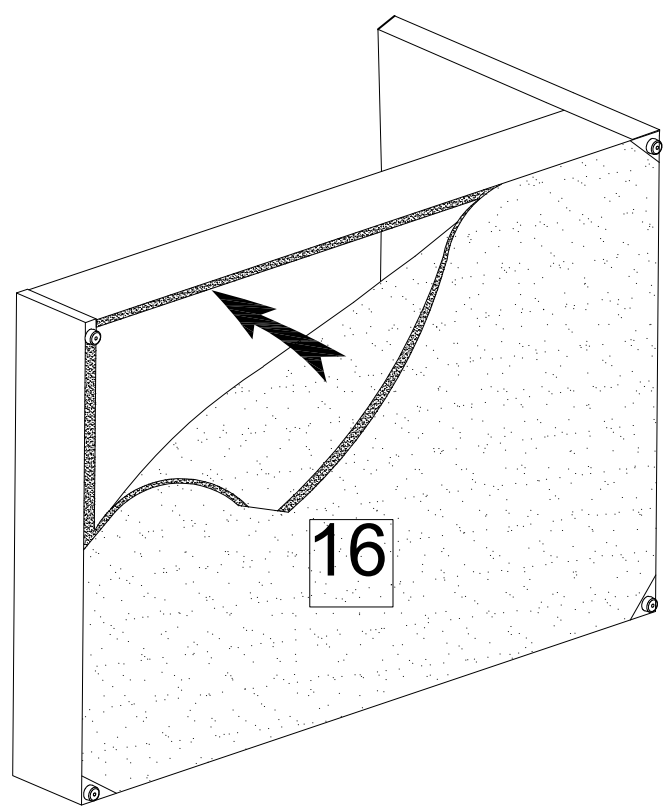


Step 4: Attaching the Central Support Rail & Angle Corner Brackets

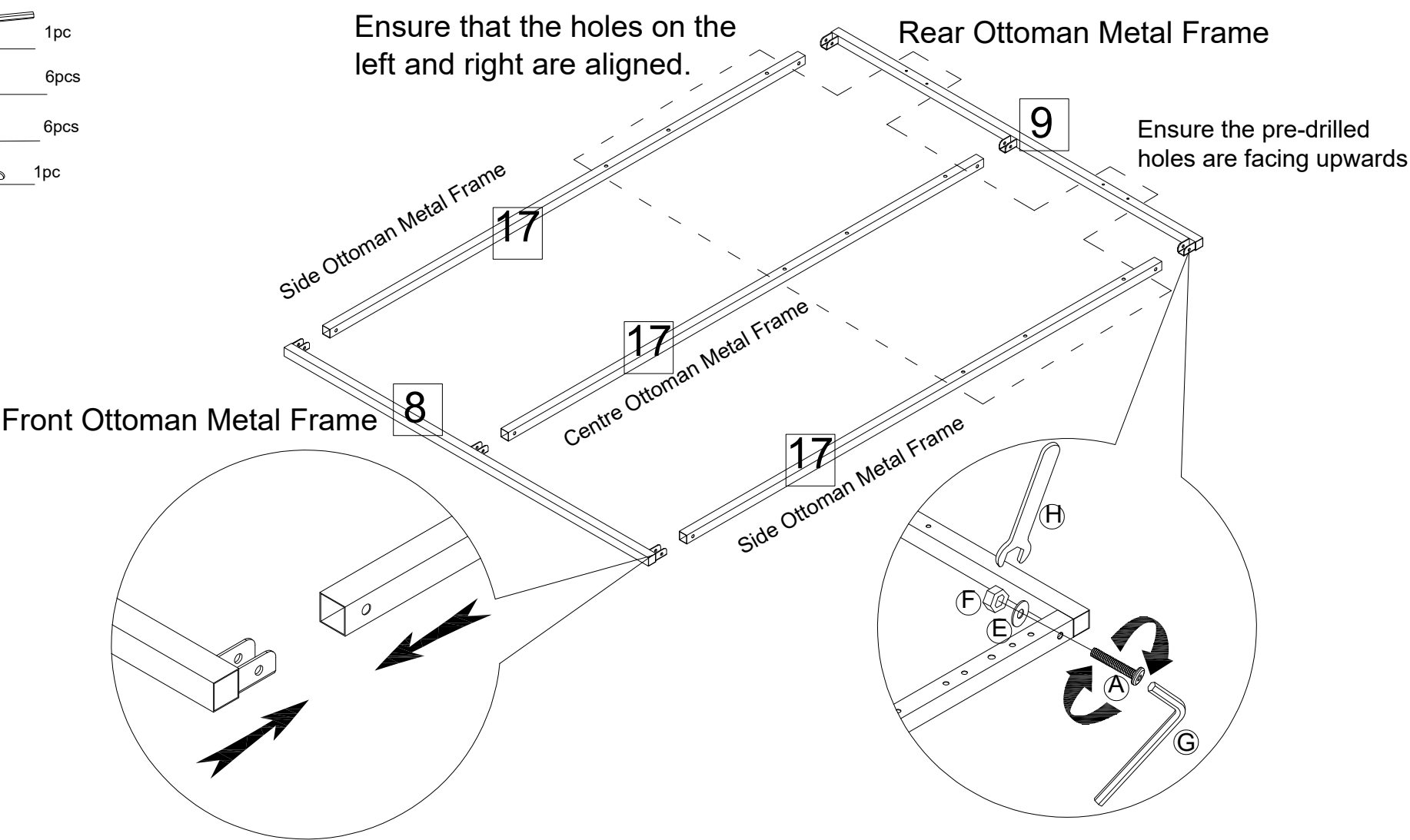
Step 5: Fabric Base Attachment



With an assistant, carefully lift both the Headboard & Footboard at the same time, do not let the bed frame twist. Lift and turn the bed frame on its side holding the bed upright for safety. Attach the Fabric Base (16) to bottom of the Side Rails, Headboard & Footboard with the velcro tape. Ensure the fabric is fixed evenly all round.

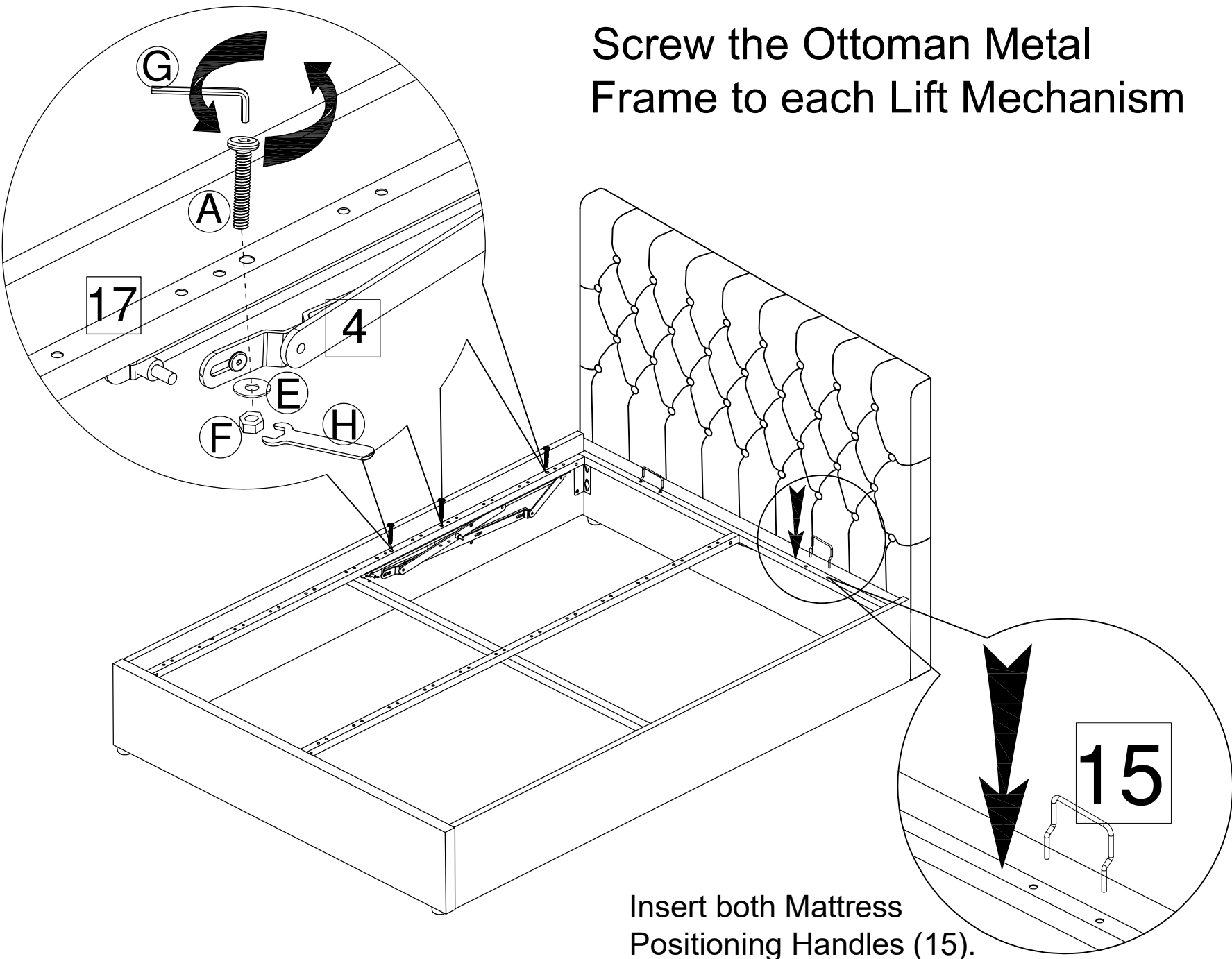

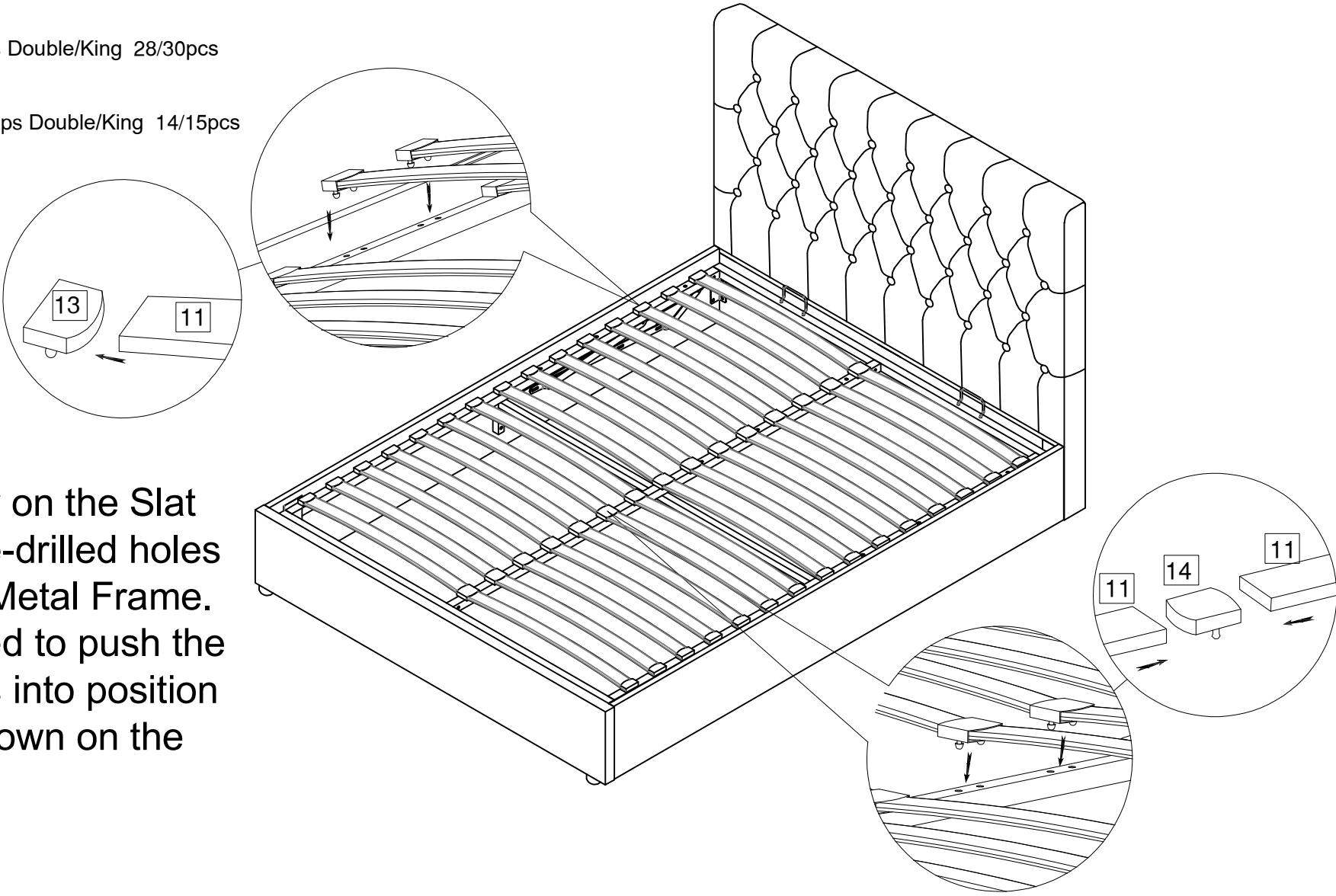


Insert both Mattress Positioning Handles (15).

Attaching the Slat Caps to the Ottoman Bed Frame

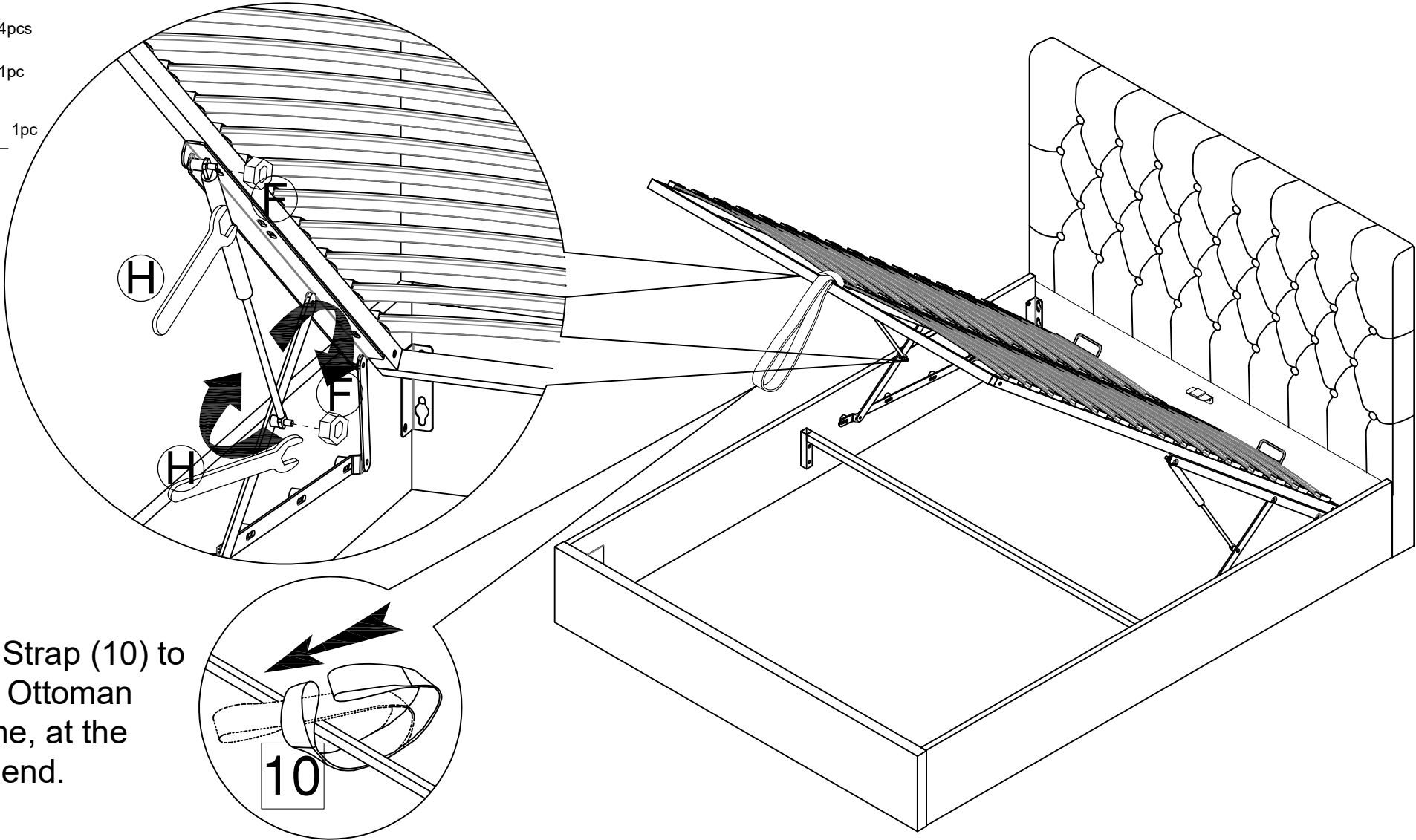
- 13 Side Slat Caps Double/King 28/30pcs
- 14 Centre Slat Caps Double/King 14/15pcs



Push down firmly on the Slat Caps into the pre-drilled holes on the Ottoman Metal Frame. It is recommended to push the Centre Slat Caps into position before pushing down on the Side Slat Caps.

Step 9: Attaching the Gas Stuts to Lift Mechanisms

- F 4pcs

Attach the Strap (10) to the Center Ottoman Metal Frame, at the Footboard end.

Care and Maintenance

Here are some good tips to keep your new ottoman bed frame in tip-top condition.

Cleaning

To clean your new ottoman bed frame, we advise using a damp cloth if the fabric is dusty or a low suction vacuum. Do not use abrasive chemicals or bleach as this may damage the product.

Checking and moving

Periodically, we recommend you check that the screws and fixtures haven't become loose over time. To move your bed frame, we recommend lifting it where possible, as dragging or pushing it could cause damage to the legs or flooring.

Fabric

Please note, depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the fabric will appear differently. Over a period of time, the fabric may also lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.

Gas strut/piston best use:

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- Only attempt to close the ottoman frame, once the mattress has been placed on the frame.
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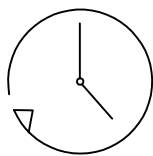
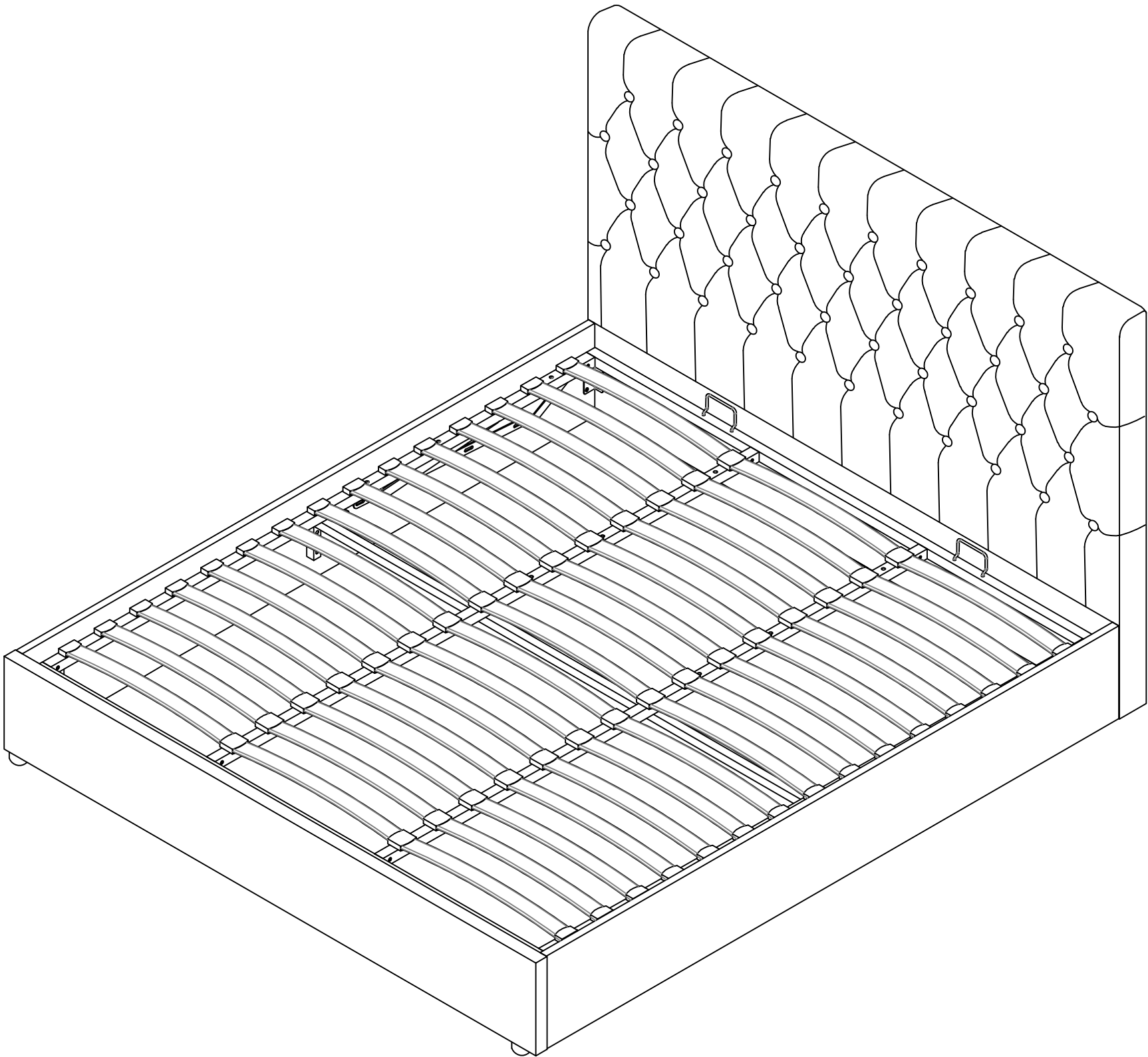
