






This product is intended for domestic use only, not for commercial purposes.

IMPORTANT

ASSEMBLY TIP

Before you begin, it's best to identify all of the parts and fittings to build your TV unit frame. We advise laying these out on the floor to check you have everything, and to familiarise yourself with all of the parts and fittings before building.

TOP TIP

We recommend that you assemble the TV unit in the room you'd like it to be located. This will help prevent any risk of damage to the frame whilst moving it.

SAFETY AND CARE

- It's important to ensure children and animals are kept away from the assembly area, as there are small components used in this product which could present a choking hazard. All plastic and wrapping materials should also be kept away from children and animals to prevent any risk of suffocation.
- 2. Do not stand on your product.
- 3. Always use the item on firm level ground, ensuring all legs remain in contact with the ground.
- 4. Place heaviest items in the lowest drawers.
- 5. Children should always be under supervision whilst using this product. Never allow children to climb on the drawers.
- 6. Never keep more than one drawer open at the same time.
- 7. Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from tipping furniture.



RECYCLING

Please ensure that packaging is disposed of in a safe and environmentally friendly way, and recycle where possible. Please keep your assembly instructions safe to refer back to in the future.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- 1. Only clean using a damp cloth, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners as they may damage the finish over time.
- 2. Do not use a very wet cloth or allow any liquid to contact with the surface for a long period of time. Wipe any spillage immediately. Absorption can cause wood to warp or finishes to de-laminate.
- 3. Do not scrub or rub the surface when cleaning.
- 4. Do not drag the TV unit when moving, lift it off the floor instead.
- 5. Use a placemat or a coaster when putting hot items (e.g. hot drinks and dishes) on the wood surface.
- 6. It is not recommended to place the item next to sources of heat such as radiators, fires or directly exposed to sunlight. This may cause the wood to crack, split or fade due to the heat and humidity.
- 7. Wood will mellow and change colour over time, we recommend that ornaments and items placed on the surface to be moved regularly to prevent uneven mellowing.
- 8. Regularly check all fixings to ensure none have come loose. Re-tighten if necessary.
- 9. Avoid sharp items such as a screwdriver or any pointy tools.
- 10. Maximum TV size 42", maximum TV weight 20kg.











3. Attach Cam Lock Screws to Right Side Bar (21) ,then attach Right Side Bar (21) and Right Side Panel (2) .




4. Attach Cam Lock Screws to Left Side Bar (20) ,then attach Left Side Bar (20) and Left Side Panel (1) .





5. Attach Cam Lock Screw to Left Side Panel (1) and Right Side Panel (2).







6. Attach Shelf (8) and Front Support Bar (10) to Right Side Panel (2).












8. Attach Left Corner Panel (3) and Right Corner Panel (4) to the Frame.




9. Insert the Upper Back Panel (9) to the Frame.




10. Attach Cam Lock Screws to Top Panel (11).







11. Attach Top Panel (11) to the Frame.




12. Insert Lower Back Panel (7) into the Frame.




13. Attach Bottom Panel (5) to the Frame.








14. Attach Legs (18) and Centre Leg (19) to the Frame.




15. Assemble the drawer by following the steps shown in the illustration below.




16. Assemble the drawer by following the steps shown in the illustration below.

17. Slide the Drawers into the Frame. The Centre Leg is adjustable if necessary.



18. Attach the plastic buckles on back. Before securing them, manually adjust the frame to ensure the drawers are properly aligned, even, and parallel.
